Although AS 1428.1 specifically excludes work to private residences, it is the most relevant standard in relation to the work carried out by the State-wide equipment program (SWEP) in the funding of home modifications for people with a Disability.

The purpose of the attached Acknowledgments and Release is to ensure that all parties are aware of a possible risk and to indicate why a non-compliant modification is required for your particular needs.
